Drukair resumes monthly charter flight to Timor-Leste.

Drukair, Royal Bhutan Airlines is happy to resume its charter operations between Singapore and Dili in partnership with NITA.

Drukair launched its first charter flight on this route in October 2019 and operated a total of 44 flights to Dili (Timor Leste) from Singapore towards end of 2019 and early 2020. Due to severe travel restrictions imposed by the pandemic, the flights had to be suspended with the last flight being operated on 29 March 2020.

After 2 years of closed borders, Drukair is happy to resume operations on this route.

The frequency will be initially once a month in September and October and gradually increase the frequency from November depending on the load.

According to the CEO, “we are very keen to resume our charter flight services to East Timor and I think this deal is a win-win for both NITA and Drukair. We get to increase our aircraft utilization and at the same time support to focus on rebuilding connectivity in the region.”
